Invitation Call for Papers  
CIB World Congress, 17-21 June 2019, Hong Kong**



CIB Working Commission W110 will organize an Designated Scientific Paper Session and a Commission Meeting as part of the CIB World Building Congress 2019, to be held in Hong Kong, 17-21 June 2019.

We invite academics, researchers, students, professionals, government officials, policy practitioners, community groups, NGOs and Real Estate agents or developers to address issues of informal settlements and housing for low income communities. Informal settlements are created through a process of unassisted self-help, in which most dwellings are built by the inhabitants. Moreover, it is to create affordable housing that includes low cost apartments, housing for disaster victims and student dormitory among others.

**Aims of the Session**

The Designated Scientific Paper Session aims to gather research results and studies on "Informal Settlements and Affordable Housing" from around the world. Researchers, students, practitioners, government officials, NGOs, and others are welcome to submit papers.
